

## JUROR Randy Hall

Randy Hall is a painter, photographer and educator living and working in San Angelo, Texas. Hall earned his BA in Art from Maharishi International University, his BFA in Studio Art from Calvin College and his MFA in painting from TCU. He has also completed doctoral coursework in Art Education at the University of North Texas.

Since 2004 Hall has been a member of the Angelo State University art faculty. Holding the rank of professor, he serves as the Art Area coordinator, curates exhibitions, and teaches courses in Drawing, Design, Graphic Illustration, Painting, Art Education, Digital Imagery, and Senior Portfolio Preparation. He has also co-taught the Great Works in the Arts course through the ASU Honors program and co-directed Study Abroad to the People's Republic of China and Scotland UK, through the Center for International Studies.

Preceding his appointment at ASU, Mr. Hall directed the art therapy program at the High Frontier, in Fort Davis, Texas, taught courses in Design and Drawing at the University of North Texas in Denton, Texas, and was Visiting Assistant Professor of Art at Grand Valley State University in Grand Rapids, Michigan, where he taught coursework in Art Education.
